



CAPTAIN DAVID S. BOYD, U. S. NAVY COMMANDER NAVAL TRAINING CENTER

Captain David S. Boyd reported to Orlando as Commander, Naval Training Center, from duty on the staff of Commander, Submarine Forces, U. S. Atlantic Fleet, Norfolk, Virginia. A 1950 graduate of the U. S. Naval Academy, his career in the submarine force has included duty in the nuclear-powered attack submarine USS SKATE (SSN-578), America's first production model nuclear-powered submarine and the first of her class. During this tour, USS SKATE passed under the North Pole in 1958 and on 17 March 1959, SKATE became the first submarine to surface at the North Pole.

Captain Boyd has commanded the nuclear-powered attack submarine USS PERMIT (SSN-594); fleet ballistic missile submarine USS THEODORE ROOSEVELT (SSBN-600); and the submarine tender USS DIXON (AS-37).



CAPTAIN EARL H. GRAFFAM, U. S. NAVY COMMANDING OFFICER RECRUIT TRAINING COMMAND

Captain Earl H. Graffam entered the Navy under the V-5 program in 1945. He subsequently attended Cornell University and graduated from Drake University in 1950. In 1952 he received his commission from the Officer Candidate School in Newport, Rhode Island. Among service colleges, Captain Graffam has attended the Naval War College and Industrial College of the Armed Forces.

Captain Graffam has served in various staff positions both at sea and ashore and his sea tours included USS FRYBARGER, USS WALTER B. COBB, USS MCMORRIS and USS FOX. He commanded the minesweeper, USS PERSISTENT and the destroyer escort, USS SCHOFIELD. Prior to assuming command of the Recruit Training Command, Orlando, on 8 September 1977, he served in the Pentagon as Head, Iranian Naval Expansion Program.


